Marwood Hill GARDENS

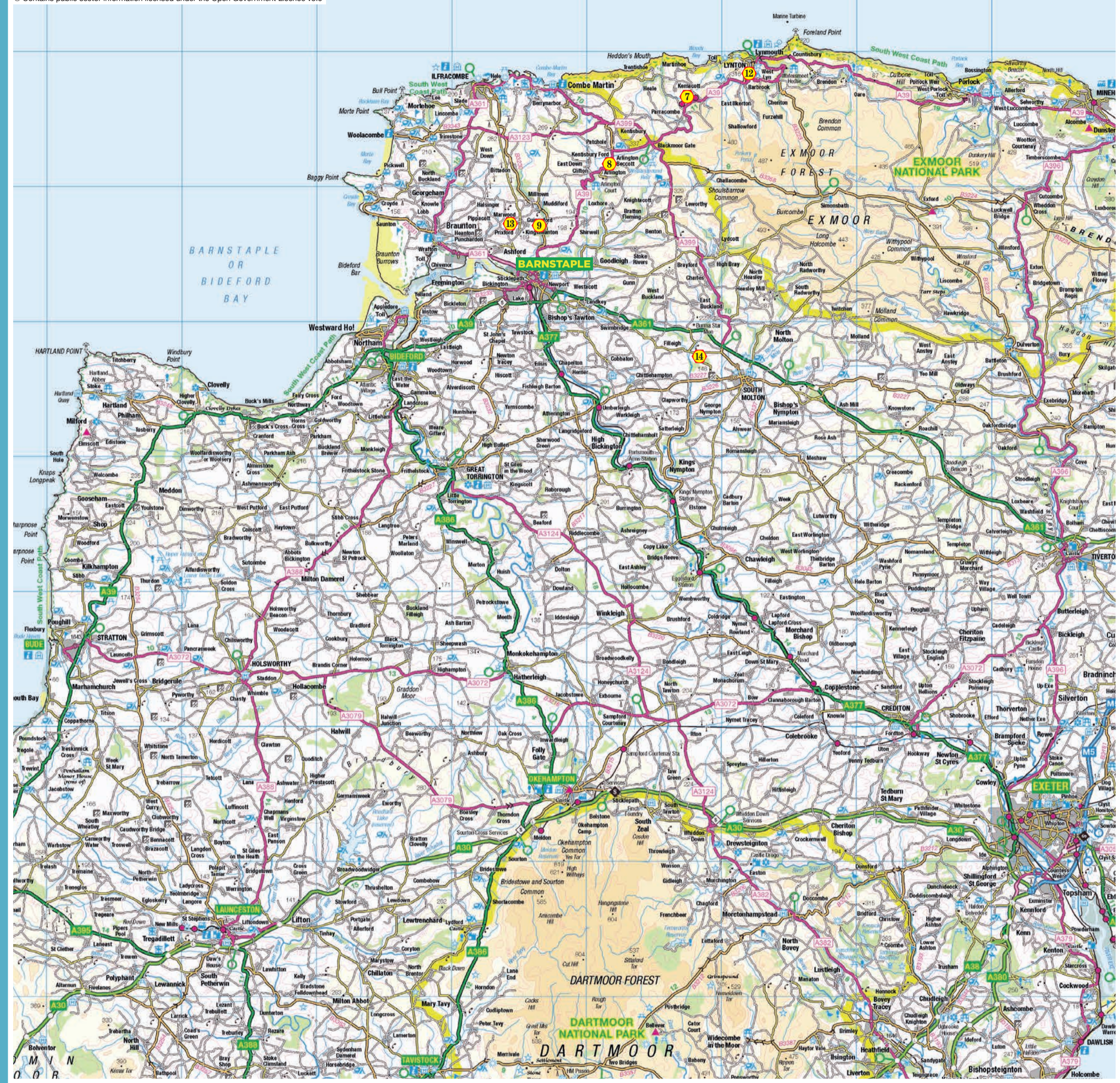

ARLINGTON COURT
Historic house with an interesting collection of small objects d'art. Gardens with rhododendrons, azaleas and hydrangeas. Carriage museum and rides. Nature trail.

BAGGY POINT
Rocky headland between Croyde Bay and Woolcombe Bay. Easy access path from the National Trust car park at Croyde Bay. Coastal panoramic views.

BRAUNTON BURROWS
At two thousand acres, this is the largest sand dune system in the UK. Dramatic scenery with steep sided high sand dunes. The dunes contain about 500 species of flowering plants. Adjacent beach, Saunton Sands, west to the reserve. Opens all year daily.
